PolyMem Dressings

- Cleans, fills and moisten wounds without adhering to skin
- Built-in cleansing agent
- Avoids the disruption of healthy tissue growth

Unna Boots

- Compression dressings infused with zinc oxide
- Forms a semi-rigid cast for support
- Eases skin irritation and keeps wound area moist
- Zinc promotes healing within wound sites
- Does not harden or cake

Wet to Dry Wraps

- Saline gauze dressing applied to the wound
- Dries and adheres to the tissue in the wound bed
- Wound drainage and dead tissue is removed

Silver Dressings

- An antimicrobial agent, silver promotes healing
- Silver infused dressings prevent bacteria from creating chemical bonds
- Silver prevents bacteria from multiplying
